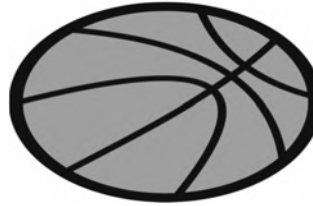

SAINT ANSELM CHURCH **JULY SAINTS**

St. Thomas, Apostle – July 3rd

Mentioned in all four Gospels and the Acts of the Apostles, Thomas is most remembered for doubting the resurrection of Our Lord, since he was not present the first time the risen Jesus appeared to the Apostles. It is when Our Lord appears a second time that Thomas declares, "My Lord and my God". While little is known of his ministry after the Ascension, by tradition, Thomas evangelized in India, establishing communities that still exist today. *Because you have seen me Thomas, you have believed; blessed are those who have not seen me and yet believe.*

St. Benedict of Nursia – July 11th

The "Father of Western Monasticism", Benedict was born in Nursia in Umbria (480 – 547). Educated in Rome, he left the city because of its decadence and settled in Subiaco, where he gathered together a group of disciples. Eventually resettling north of Naples, Benedict founded the abbey of Monte Casino, establishing what became known as the Benedictine Order. While inspired by the monasticism practiced in the East, Benedict, nevertheless felt that his monks should lead a more balanced life of "Prayer and Work" – "Ora et Labora". *He lived as a hermit in the presence of the all-seeing God.*

St. Kateri Tekakawitha – July 14th

Born to a Christian Algonquin mother and a Mohawk father (1656 – 1680), Kateri was left an orphan, at the age of 4, when small pox killed her parents and younger brother and left her horribly scared. Her Mohawk uncle then raised her. At the age of 19 she converted to Catholicism and took the name Kateri, after St. Catherine of Siena. After her Baptism she began to practice severe penances, fasts, and daily periods of meditation. She died at the age of 24 and is known as the "Lily of the Mohawks". *These holy ones seek the Lord; they long to see him face to face.*

Sts. Joachim and Anne – July 26th

While both the gospels of Matthew and Luke trace the lineage of Our Lord through St. Joseph, there is no place in scripture that the ancestry of the Blessed Virgin may be found. It is by pious tradition, first recorded in the 2nd century, that we receive the names – Joachim and Anne. How accurate the oral account may, or may not be, we may be certain that Mary was raised by loving, prayer-filled parents. *They prayed that God would come to save his people. They looked forward to the deliverance of Israel.*

St. Ignatius Loyola – July 31st

Born in Loyola (1491 – 1556), in northern Spain, Ignatius grew up in a noble family. Expecting to pursue a career in the army, a cannon ball ended his dreams of military advancement. He underwent a spiritual conversion during his long convalescence, reading the scriptures, the life of Christ, and the lives of the saints. Following his conversion, Ignatius wrote one of the great works of Christian mysticism – the Spiritual Exercises. In 1534, Ignatius, along with six companions (one of whom was St. Francis Xavier) took vows of poverty and chastity. Pope Paul III approved the creation of the Jesuit order in 1540 – to the greater glory of God. *Whoever speaks should proclaim God's message; so that in all of you God may be glorified through Jesus Christ.*
