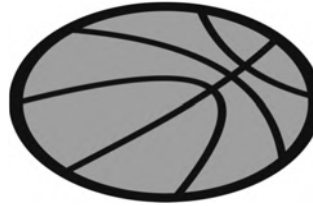

## **SAINT ANSELM CHURCH** **AUGUST SAINTS**

### **St. John Vianney – August 4<sup>th</sup>**

Born in 1786, Jean Baptiste Marie Vianney grew up in a devout Catholic home. When he was 4 years old the French Revolutionary government initiated anti-clerical laws making the public practice of the faith difficult. As a result of this period of turmoil, Vianney's studies, especially in Latin, were extremely poor, hampering his effort to obtain ordination. Finally ordained in 1815, Vianney was assigned three years later to the parish of Ars where he spent 10 to 16 hours a day, hearing confessions and counseling people. St. John is honored as the Patron of Parish Priests.

*Prayer is nothing else but union with God.*

### **St. Dominic – August 8<sup>th</sup>**

St. Dominic was born in northern Spain in 1170. Becoming a canon of the cathedral chapter of Osma, Dominic accompanied his bishop on a journey to Denmark, Rome, and eventually southern France, where he encountered the Albigensian heresy, which considered all the material world evil, denying the Incarnation, the Sacraments, and the belief that God having created the world – blessed it and called it good. Dominic was moved to preach against their errors, establishing in 1215 the Order of Preachers, or Dominicans. *True teaching was in his mouth. No evil was ever found on his lips.*

### **St. Clare – August 11<sup>th</sup>**

Chiara Offreduccio was born in Assisi in 1194 into the wealthy family. Hearing St. Francis preach at a Lenten service, Clare was moved to follow him in Apostolic poverty, taking the veil on Palm Sunday in 1212 over the great opposition of her father. Subsequently joined by her sister, Clare established a community of nuns at San Damiano in Assisi intent on living a life modeled on the Gospels. Her zeal in caring for the poor and her wisdom caused popes, bishops and common people to seek her counsel. *I count all this world worthless, that I may gain Christ and be found in him.*

### **St. Pius X – August 21<sup>st</sup>**

Pope Pius X was born Giuseppe Sarto in 1835 into a poor family in northern Italy. He served as both bishop of Mantua and Patriarch of Venice before being elected pope in 1903. As pope he opposed the interference in papal elections by European governments. While a great proponent of liturgical reform, Pius is best remembered for encouraging the frequent and early reception of the Eucharist by the laity. Canonized in 1954, a window in our church honors this great 20<sup>th</sup> century pope. *When we speak, we strive to please God and not men.*

### **Sts. Monica & Augustine – Aug. 23<sup>rd</sup> & 24<sup>th</sup>**

It is largely through the prayers of Augustine's holy mother, St. Monica, that we have the saint we know today. Born in north Africa in 354 to his devout Christian mother and pagan father, Augustine's early life was anything but saintly. For 15 years he lived with a woman, fathering a son, but never marrying. He became a convert to Manichaeism, a system of belief, which saw the material world as evil. But, St. Monica's prayers were finally answered when St. Ambrose at the Easter Vigil of 387 baptized him. After his baptism, Augustine returned to Africa to teach. He was ordained in 390 and became bishop of Hippo five years later. A prolific writer, his most important theological works are "Confessions" and "The City of God". *O truth, you are the light of my heart. Let your light speak to me.*





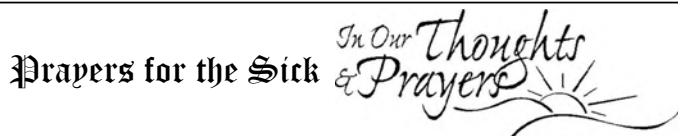
