SAINT ANSELM CHURCH **NOVEMBER SAINTS**

St. Charles Borromeo – November 4th

Born in 1538 into a noble family, Charles's deep spirituality and integrity caused his uncle, Pius IV, to make him a cardinal and entrust him with matters of importance to the Church. Through his efforts, the Council of Trent was reconvened. Charles then set to work reforming the liturgy and clergy in his own archdiocese of Milan. During the famine of 1576 he stayed in the city and went into debt to feed thousands daily. He died in 1584 at the age of 46. *Seek after integrity and holiness, faith and love, patience and gentleness.*

St. Martin of Tours – November 11th

Martin was born in 313 to pagan parents, in what is today Hungary. His father, being a retired Roman legionnaire, pressured him into joining the army at the age of 15. At 18, Martin was baptized and settled in France after his release from military service. Martin reluctantly accepted consecration as Bishop of Tours. As bishop he opposed the practice of putting heretics to death and the involvement of the state in Church affairs. Martin died in 397 AD. He is best remembered for his charity – especially the story of his cutting his cloak in half to share with a beggar. *Happy this man who did not deceive, nor judge, nor condemn anyone.*

St. Elizabeth of Hungary – November 17th

The daughter of a King of Hungary, Elizabeth was born in 1207. At the age of 14 she married Louis of Thuringia, by whom she had 3 children. Spending huge amounts to feed the poor from the castle kitchen, Elizabeth was thrown out of the castle by her husband's family when he died while on a crusade. As a widow, Elizabeth joined the Secular Franciscan Order and established a hospital for the sick. She died at the age of 24. *Your prayers and generosity have been accepted in God's sight.*

St. Menas, Martyr – November 24th

While little known in the west, in Egypt, St. Menas is one of the most highly venerated of martyrs. After serving in the Roman army, he retired to a life of solitude and prayer. But, he left his desert retreat to protest the anti-Christian edicts of the Emperor Diocletian, an act of faith and courage for which Menas was martyred around 296 AD. *Blessed are those who suffer persecution for the sake of justice.*

St. Catherine Laboure – November 25th

Born in 1806, young Zoe's father sent her to live with her brother, in Paris. In an effort to deter her from choosing a religious life. But, seeing the many poor in the city, Zoe committed herself firmly to joining the Sisters of Charity of St. Vincent de Paul, choosing the name Catherine. Beginning in 1830 Catherine received a series of visions of the Blessed Mother, who instructed her to have a medal cast as a source of graces, the Miraculous Medal. She died in 1876. *O Mary, conceived without sin, pray for us who have recourse to thee.*

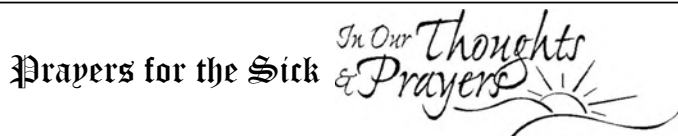
